TECHNICAL INSTALLATION GUIDE

Signposts are an important feature of any well planned street, nature reserve and general public places and provide information or direction to those that need them. Plaswood signs have attained a high level of credibility over a number of years and have proven to be the 'green alternative' to timber, metal and concrete signs.

Waymarker Signage Post Installation

A concrete foundation setting is recommended with a minimum of 500mm of the Plaswood post below the ground. Average waymarker sits around 1200mm above ground. Long nails or metal pegs could be used to key the post into the concrete. This will also aid stability.

Additional Options

All posts can have either flat, bevelled or chamfered tops which enhance the finish of the signs product. Corporate logos can also be added, along with various text and font styles.

We also offer Finger Posts, Street Name Plates, Information Boards, Management Posts, Nature Reserve Signs, Nature Trail Signs and Roundabout Sponsorship Signs, which are all suitable for any outdoor environment.

General Notes

Plaswood signs have attained a high level of credibility over a number of years and have proven to be the 'green alternative' to timber, metal and concrete signs. They need little or no maintenance and have no scrap value, which are assets in themselves with the vandal problems experienced in many areas.

Waymarker Posts

Sections used 100mm square or 225mm x 75mm black Plaswood.

Post symbols vary according to customer requirements and can be either to one face or two. Any symbol can be either routed into the surface and then in filled with paint or plaques can be made which can be fixed or recessed into the posts.
